Sacha Jafri is a young British contemporary artist renowned for his large-scale, emotionally charged paintings that explore themes of humanity, connection, and spirituality. A graduate of the Royal Academy Schools, Jafri first gained recognition for his vibrant, map-like depictions of cities like London and New York.

His practice is characterised by an intricate, multi-layered process, often incorporating mixed media and a distinctive, expressive use of color. Jafri achieved global acclaim in 2021 when his painting The Journey of Humanity sold for \$62 million, a record for a living artist at auction. The work, created during the COVID-19 lockdown and notable as the world's largest canvas, cemented his reputation as an artist with significant international reach, particularly in the Middle East.

Jafri's career has been marked by high-profile philanthropic projects, including a major series of works created for the London 2012 Olympic Games. His art is held in prestigious public and private collections worldwide, and he continues to be a prominent figure at the intersection of contemporary art and global humanitarian initiatives.

His practice is characterised by an intricate, multi-layered process, often incorporating mixed media and a distinctive, expressive use of color. Jafri achieved global acclaim in 2021 when his painting **The Journey of Humanity sold for \$62 million**, a record for a living artist at auction. The work, created during the COVID-19 lockdown and notable as the world's largest canvas, cemented his reputation as an artist with significant international reach, particularly in the Middle East.

Sacha Jafri is now considered one of the world's leading young artists. As the youngest artist in the History of Art to be offered a 10yr Retrospective visiting the top Museums of the world and having recently pipped Damien Hirst to Top Spot in auction in London, Sacha has become the first ever artist to be featured on the front cover of both the New York Times + Financial Times, who have recently described him as a 'Shrewd Investment'. This has since been amplified by his recent Sell-Out World Tour with a lost Andy Warhol collection entitled 'Jafri meets Warhol' that visited the top 12 Museums from over 10 countries of the world.

Sacha's key work now typically sells for between \$250,000-\$750,000 with his recent live painting selling in auction at the Islamic Museum in Doha for \$1million Dollars.

Jafri was awarded as Young Artist of the year in New York and received an award from the UN for his artistic and humanitarian work having personally raised over \$14million Dollars from the sale of his work for various charities around the globe.

Collectors of Jafri's work include: Bill Gates, Bernie Ecclestone, George Clooney, President Obama, President Clinton, John McEnroe, David Beckham, Sir Richard Branson, HH Prince Albert of Monaco, The King of Spain, Dame Vivienne Westwood, Sir Philip Green, The Mittal family, Sir Ben Kingsley, Sir Paul Smith, Madonna, Leonardo Di Caprio, as well as the Royal Families of Dubai, Abu Dhabi, Qatar, Kuwait, Saudi Arabia, Bahrain and Sharjah, amongst many other corporate and private collections, museum collections and leading houses of modern art.

THE RING MASTER (2008-2012)

Working Title

'The Ringmaster' painting with handprints and footprints of British Olympians.

Description

This work is a central piece from Jafri's Olympic Countdown series. It is characterised by its dynamic composition and, most significantly, the direct physical incorporation of handprints and footprints of British Olympians into the canvas. The title The Ringmaster metaphorically positions the artist as the conductor of this collective athletic and artistic endeavour.


